Caucasus Barometer

- Representative survey of the populations of Georgia and Armenia
- Data from 10 waves of Caucasus Barometer surveys, from 2008 up to now are available on our website (caucasusbarometer.org)
- Caucasus Barometer is cited in over 3,200 academic and policy papers

Caucasus Barometer

- Caucasus Barometer Georgia is representative of the adult population of the country, excluding the occupied territories
- In addition to being nationally representative, it is representative of Tbilisi, other urban, and rural settlements
- On average, 2,100 respondents are surveyed in each wave, and the average margin of error ranges between 2.2% and 2.8%
- In 2004-2019, interviews were conducted face-to-face, and from 2015 using tablet computer. The 2020 wave was conducted using the telephone interviewing method

Caucasus Barometer: 2020

- Fieldwork dates: December 8-14, 2020
- Response rate: 29%
- Sample size: 1,504 respondents selected through random digit dialing were interviewed using the telephone interviewing method
- Interview languages: Azerbaijani, Armenian, Georgian, and Russian
- Margin of error:
 - For proportions near 5% and 95%: +/-0.7%
 - For proportions near 10% and 90%: +/-2.7%
 - For proportions near 25% and 75%: +/-3.7%
 - For proportions near 40% and 60%: +/-6.4%
 - For proportions near 50%: +/-7.4%



Have you ever been tested for Covid-19?


20% of the population has been tested for Covid-19





As a result of the outbreak, did your life change a great deal, a fair amount, not too much, or not at all?


A large share of the population says that their life changed a fair amount or a great deal as a result of the pandemic. About 69% report changes, while life has not changed too much or at all for 31%

Views are split on regulations. The majority supports regulations/limita tions. About a third would support removing them.




Employment and the economic situation



Which of the following best describes your situation?


About 43% of the population says they are employed, which is consistent with data from previous waves





In the last 12 months did anyone in your family...


9% of respondents say that in the last 12 months someone in their family started a new job. 29% say someone in their family lost a job.





Does your family earn much less, somewhat less, somewhat more or much more than at this time last year?


Two thirds of the population says that their family earns less than last year





In your opinion, financial situation of your family will improve, stay the same, or get worse in a year's time?


Over one third of the population is pessimistic about their financial situation. A quarter is not certain about it.

For the majority of the population, salaries, pensions, and state aid are the main sources of income. The share receiving remittances has decreased.




Politics and institutions

A slightly larger share of the population believes the country is going in the wrong direction than in the right direction.






In your opinion, what is the most important issue in Georgia currently?

As in previous years, people consider unemployment to be the main problem, which is followed by Covid-19. The share of other economic problems is also quite high.





People trust religious institutions and the army the most. The least trusted institutions are political parties and non-governmental organizations






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust religious institutions, to which you belong?






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the Georgian army?






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the police?






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the healthcare system?






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the education system?






Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the executive government?












Please tell me how much you trust or distrust the court system?











Which of these statements is closest to your opinion?


Over half of the population believes that democracy is preferable to any other kind of governance. This is the highest rate of democracy support since 2013.





Half the population supports a paternalistic role for government














Would you say that those elections were conducted ...

Respondents' views are split over the 2020 Parliamentary Elections.




International issues



To what extent do you support Georgia's membership in the EU?


An absolute majority of the population supports Georgia's membership in the EU. This rate has been one of the highest in recent years





To what extent do you support Georgia's membership in NATO?


A large share of the population supports Georgia's membership in NATO as well






To what extent do you support Georgia's membership in the Eurasian Union?

Have you heard of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict?






Do you agree or disagree that the recent conflict in Nagorno-Karabakh was avoidable?

Of those respondents who have heard of the conflict (70%)


Respondents think it was possible to avoid the war
