

# Factsheet

Teacher Reporting of Violence against Children and Women survey in Georgia was conducted by CRRC-Georgia between May 29 and June 14, 2019 for UN-Women. Within the study, CRRC-Georgia studied behavioral levers that can encourage teachers to report suspected cases of domestic violence.

**Population:** Teacher employed in the public secondary schools in Georgia.

**Sample Design:** Cluster sampling with preliminary stratification.

**Sample Size:** 1,494 respondents.

**Response rate:** 72%

**Survey mode:** Computer assisted self-interviewing (CASI).

**Interview languages:** Georgian, Armenian and Azerbaijani.

**Fieldwork Dates:** May 29, 2019 to June 14, 2019.

**Results are weighted.**
